

OPENER, MIDDLE BREAK:

Circle Left. Stomp, stomp them grapes.

Left Allemande, Turn Thru and then,
Left Allemande and Weave.

Swing your girl, Promenade.

Hoping she'd come back home.

FIGURE:

Heads [sides] Promenade, go half way.
Down the middle, Square Thru 4.
Go all the way, then Right & Left Thru.
Veer Left and Ferris Wheel, Centers Square Thru 3 hands.
Swing the corner, Promenade.
I've gotta lose the blues now, boys,
And get my girl back home.

CLOSER:

Circle Left. Stomp, stomp them grapes.
Mash those grapes into wine.
Left Allemande, Turn Thru and then,
Left Allemande and Weave.
Yesterday she loved me,
Now today she's gone.
Why she'd want to leave me,
Is a deep dark mystery.
